पर्यावरण-अनुकूल प्रथाओं को बढ़ावा देने और प्लास्टिक को ख़ासत को कम करने के उद्देश्य से, संस्थान कागज़ के थैले बनाने की कार्यशालाओं का आयोजन तेजी से कर रहे हैं।

ये कार्यशालाएँ अक्सर जैसी पुनर्चकित सामग्रियों से कागज़ के थैले बनाने का व्यावहारिक अनुभव प्रदान करती हैं और प्रतिभागियों को प्लास्टिक थैलों का एक स्थायी विकल्प सिखाती हैं। इस तरह की पहल न केवल प्लास्टिक प्रदूषण के चारे में जागरूकता बढ़ाती है, बल्कि व्यक्तियों को पर्यावरण पर सकारात्मक प्रभाव डालने के लिए व्यावहारिक कौशल भी

प्रदान करती हैं। कुछ लाभ निम्नलिखित हैं: ये कार्यशालाएँ बच्चों लाभदायक हैं, यहाँ कलात्मक गंध है; स्थायित्व को बढ़ावा/कागज़ के थैले थापों/डिपेंडेंसल होते हैं और प्लास्टिक की तुलना में इन्हें रीसायकल करना आसान होता है, जिससे ये पर्यावरण के लिए अधिक अनुकूल विकल्प बन जाते हैं।

प्लास्टिक कचरे को कम करें: कागज़ के थैलों के उपयोग को प्रोत्साहित करके, ये कार्यशालाएँ एकल-उपयोग वाले प्लास्टिक थैलों की माँग को कम करने में मदद करती हैं, जिससे पर्यावरण को स्वच्छ बनाने में योगदान मिलता है। व्यावहारिक कौशल: प्रतिभाग एक मूल्यवान कौशल सीखते हैं जिसका उपयोग उनके दैनिक जीवन में किया जा सकता है और संभावित रूप से छोटे पैमाने पर आय सृजन का भी मार्ग प्रशस्त कर सकता है। सामुदायिक जुड़ाव: कार्यशालाएँ एक समुदाय-निर्माण गतिविधि हो सकती हैं, जो पर्यावरण संरक्षण के प्रति समूहिक जिम्मेदारी को भावना को बढ़ावा देती हैं।

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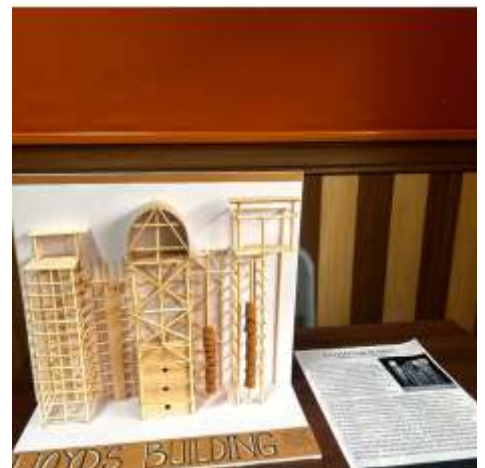
